
## NEW RULES FOR DRIVERS FROM 1<sup>ST</sup> MARCH 2016

Drivers who pass a bicycle rider must allow a distance of at least:

- > 1 metre when the speed limit is 60km/h or less
- > 1.5 metres when the speed limit is more than 60km/h

## **PENALTIES APPLY**

Drivers will be exempt from some road rules, as long as it is safe to pass the bicycle rider with at least a metre of space and they have a clear view of approaching traffic.
