Our many successes this term would not be possible without your support!

#### **Staffing**

We have two exciting pieces of news in regards to staffing and permanent positions: Interviews for our second Assistant Principal's position (commencing in 2019), will take place shortly, and we should know about the successful applicant in Term 4. Secondly, we have been appointed a graduate teacher for 2019. Her name is Eliza Barnett and she will be visiting our school for the first time on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October (first day of Term 4). 
