Best Effort, Positive Care and Respect, Safety

Green: teacher correction procedure > discuss expectations

Yellow: teacher's discretion regarding referral to planning room > time with teacher > referral slip to teacher > entered on EBS

Red: executive intervention > planning room > referral slip to teacher > parent contact > entered on EBS

<u>Black:</u> immediate principal or executive intervention > planning room > parent contact > 'Behaviour Action Plan' > entered on EBS

- * Ongoing GREEN behaviours can be taken to a YELLOW level under teacher's discretion.
- ** If a student has 3 YELLOW slips per term, they will be placed on a RED level.
- *** Parent contact is to be made after the 2nd YELLOW behaviour slip or a RED level behaviour. Parents will be invited to a meeting with the class teacher or member of the executive to discuss support strategies.
- ~ **All students** will be supported with procedural fairness. Teacher discretion is paramount to ensure fair treatment by all students, taking into consideration all extenuating circumstances that impact on the student's behaviour.
